SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

In Westfield and environs in Hamilton County, Indiana

AVAILABILITY

This schedule is available to all school customers as defined in IC 20-18-2-16, electing Gas Delivery Service for space heating, water heating, cooking and other gas service. Applicant must be located on Company's gas mains suitable and adequate for supplying this service.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

All gas delivered will be billed on a per therm basis as measured by the Company.

RATES

MINIMUM CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the Customer Charge as stated above. In no event shall the Customer Charge be waived during the billing months of April through October. If the customer requests disconnection of service between the billing months of April through October and subsequent reconnection is within twelve (12) months, the Company may apply the minimum monthly charge for the months service has been disconnected plus the reconnection charge.

SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION SERVICE (cont'd)

COLLECTION CHARGE

On the first \$3.00 or less of net billing	10%
On the amount in excess of \$3.00	3%

Bills shall be rendered and due monthly. If paid within 17 days from date thereof, as stated on the bill, the net amount shall be paid. If not paid within 17 days, the gross bill which includes the collection charge is the amount to be paid.

RELATED CHARGES

Customer shall reimburse Company for all charges incurred on Customer's behalf in connection with transportation of gas for Customer's account, including any pipeline penalty charges or cashout provisions assessed to Company.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Service hereunder shall be subject to the Company's Rules and Regulations and to the Rules and Standards of Service for Gas Public Utilities prescribed by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission from time to time.

SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION PROVISIONS

A School Transportation Service Customer must become a member of a Supplier Pool pursuant to the provisions of the School Pooling Service rate. The 3rd Party Supplier will be responsible for managing the Pool's gas supply. Customer shall enter into a Gas Delivery Service Agreement with Company that designates its selected 3rd Party Supplier from a list of approved 3rd Party Suppliers that have signed a 3rd Party Supplier Application with Company. Such elections will carry over from month to month unless Customer and 3rd Party Supplier notify Company of any change at least twenty-one (21) business days prior to the start of the next billing cycle.

SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION SERVICE (cont'd)

GAS SUPPLY

This rate schedule and the above-stated rates and charges do not provide for a supply of Gas. Gas Supply Service is available from the Company under the Commercial Service Rate.

GAS SUPPLY FROM 3RD PARTY SUPPLIERS

It is the Customer's responsibility to ensure that the 3rd Party Supplier delivers its directed proportion of gas supplies to the Company's designated delivery point.

The Company also reserves the right to bill the Customer at the Commercial Service Rate for gas consumed, following cessation of any agreement with a 3rd Party Supplier.

3rd Party Suppliers of Customers in a Supplier Pool will be notified by the Company on a monthly basis as to the level of Forecasted Monthly Requirements to be delivered by the 3rd Party Supplier on behalf of the Customer, five (5) days prior to the following month. Scheduled City Gate Deliveries must equal the month's Forecasted Monthly Requirements in order to avoid Delivery Imbalances as defined in Appendix E and Nomination Error charges as defined in the School Pooling Service rate.

With thirty (30) days notice prior to expiration of Customers contracts with 3rd Party Suppliers, Customers may choose to purchase Gas Supply from the Company under the Commercial Service Rate, at the Company's sole discretion. Such service shall not be unreasonably withheld.

Customers may switch 3rd Party Suppliers once each calendar year at no additional charge, but will not be permitted to switch from 3rd Party Supplier to the Commercial Service Rate or vice versa more than one time per 12-month period. Customers who switch 3rd Party Suppliers more than once each calendar year will be subject to Switching Charges of \$25.00 per switch, per meter.

SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION SERVICE (cont'd)

In the event of 3rd Party Supplier default, the Customer shall be returned to the Commercial Service Rate or may designate another 3rd Party Supplier. The Customer shall be liable for its portion of applicable charges owed by defaulting 3rd Party Supplier, as determined by Company after review of all available facts and circumstances including documented deliveries and consumption.

GAS IMBALANCE PROVISIONS

Delivery Imbalances for Supplier Pools, arising from differences in the level of Forecasted Monthly Requirements compared to the level of Monthly Gas Supply Deliveries, will be monitored for all School Customers of a 3rd Party Supplier in a Supplier Pool. Charges for all Delivery Imbalances will be billed, at month end, to 3rd Party Suppliers as defined in Appendix E.

Usage Imbalances for Supplier Pools, arising from differences in the level of accumulated Monthly Gas Supply Deliveries compared to the monthly level of gas consumed by Customers in Supplier Pools, will be used to adjust Forecasted Monthly Requirements provided to 3rd Party Suppliers for the following month.
