

GAS RATE NO. D60

SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION SERVICE

APPLICABILITY:

This schedule is available to all school customers as defined in IC 20-18-2-16, electing Gas Delivery Service for space heating, water heating, cooking and other gas service. Customer must be located on Company's gas mains suitable and adequate for supplying this service.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

Incorporated herein, and made part of this Gas Rate No. D60, are the Terms and Conditions for Gas Service, as amended from time to time. Capitalized terms used in this rate schedule are defined in the Terms and Conditions for Gas Service.

CUSTOMER CHARGE:

\$5.79 per Meter per Month

The total Customer Charge will be the sum of all applicable per Meter charges.

DELIVERY CHARGE:

\$0.3709 Per Therm For the First 120 Therms Delivered Each Month

\$0.2688 Per Therm For the Next 380 Therms Delivered Each Month

\$0.2549 Per Therm For All Therms Over 500 Delivered Each Month

In addition, the applicable Normal Temperature Adjustment from Appendix D, Energy Efficiency Adjustment from Appendix E, and Regulatory Asset Amortization from Appendix F shall apply to all Therms delivered.

RELATED CHARGES:

Customer shall reimburse Company for all charges incurred on Customer's behalf in connection with transportation of gas for Customer's account, including any pipeline penalty charges or cashout provisions assessed to Company.

Gas Rate No. D60 – School Transportation Service (cont’d)

SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION PROVISIONS

A School Transportation Service Customer must become a member of a Supplier Pool pursuant to the provisions of the School Pooling Service rate. The 3rd Party Supplier will be responsible for managing the Pool’s gas supply. Customer shall enter into a Gas Delivery Service Agreement with Company that designates its selected 3rd Party Supplier from a list of approved 3rd Party Suppliers that have signed a 3rd Party Supplier Application with Company. Such elections will carry over from month to month unless Customer and 3rd Party Supplier notify Company of any change at least twenty-one (21) business days prior to the start of the next billing cycle.

GAS SUPPLY

This rate schedule and the above-stated charges do not provide for a supply of Gas. Gas Supply Service is available from the Company under the Commercial Delivery & Supply Service.

OTHER:

Automated Meter Reading applies, in accordance with Gas Rate No. A1.

GAS SUPPLY FROM 3RD PARTY SUPPLIERS

It is the Customer’s responsibility to ensure that the 3rd Party Supplier delivers its directed proportion of gas supplies to the Company’s designated delivery point.

The Company also reserves the right to bill the Customer at the Commercial Delivery & Supply Service rate for gas consumed, following cessation of any agreement with a 3rd Party Supplier.

3rd Party Suppliers of Customers in a Supplier Pool will be notified by the Company on a monthly basis as to the level of Forecasted Monthly Requirements to be delivered by the 3rd Party Supplier on behalf of the Customer, five (5) days prior to the following month. Scheduled City Gate Deliveries must equal the month’s Forecasted Monthly Requirements in order to avoid Delivery Imbalances as defined in Gas Rate No. A3 and Nomination Error charges as defined in the School Pooling Service rate.

With thirty (30) days notice prior to expiration of Customer contracts with 3rd Party Suppliers, Customer may choose to purchase Gas Supply from the Company under the Commercial Delivery & Supply Service Rate, at the Company’s sole discretion. Such service shall not be unreasonably withheld.

Gas Rate No. D60 – School Transportation Service (cont’d)

Customer may switch 3rd Party Suppliers once each calendar year at no additional charge, but will not be permitted to switch from 3rd Party Supplier to the Commercial Delivery & Supply Service Rate or vice versa more than one time per 12-month period. Customers who switch 3rd Party Suppliers more than once each calendar year will be subject to Switching Charges of \$25.00 per switch, per meter.

In the event of 3rd Party Supplier default, the Customer shall be returned to the Commercial Delivery & Supply Service Rate or may designate another 3rd Party Supplier. The Customer shall be liable for its portion of applicable charges owed by defaulting 3rd Party Supplier, as determined by Company after review of all available facts and circumstances including documented deliveries and consumption.

UNACCOUNTED-FOR GAS:

The Company will retain the allowance for Unaccounted-For Gas volumes tendered for delivery to Customer for Unaccounted-For Gas as approved by the Commission under Gas Rate No. A2.

GAS IMBALANCE PROVISIONS

Delivery Imbalances for Supplier Pools, arising from differences in the level of Forecasted Monthly Requirements compared to the level of Monthly Gas Supply Deliveries, will be monitored for all School Customers of a 3rd Party Supplier in a Supplier Pool. Charges for all Delivery Imbalances will be billed, at month end, to 3rd Party Suppliers as defined under Gas Rate No. A3.

Usage Imbalances for Supplier Pools, arising from differences in the level of accumulated Monthly Gas Supply Deliveries compared to the monthly level of gas consumed by Customers in Supplier Pools, will be used to adjust Forecasted Monthly Requirements provided to 3rd Party Suppliers for the following month.
